The **T**oxic **S**ubstances **C**ontrol **A**ct 1976 (TSCA) is an important standard in US American chemical regulation which the US American environmental authority, known as the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), is charged with implementing.



The EPA is responsible for maintaining an inventory of all chemical substances produced or processed in the United States or imported into the United States.

On 6 January 2021, the US-American environmental authority (EPA) published new regulations under TSCA Section 6(h) in order to restrict the import and use of five persistent, bioaccumulative toxic (PBT) chemicals.

The five persistent bioaccumulative toxic (PBT) chemicals are as follows:

PIP (3:1) (Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1)), CAS-no. 68937-41-7

PCTP (Pentachlorothiophenol), CAS-no. 133-49-3

DECA BDE (Decabromodiphenylether), CAS-no. 1163-19-5

2,4,6 TTBP (2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol, CAS-no. 732-26-3

HCBD (Hexachlorobutadiene), CAS-no. 87-68-3

Since the 5 chemicals were announced, NORWE has looked into the subject and assessed in conjunction with its manufacturers and suppliers whether these chemicals are used in the production of the plastic materials or additives required for the manufacture of our components.

Currently, all NORWE standard plastic materials do not contain any of the 5 restricted chemicals in accordance with TSCA.
